

RULES FOR EXHIBITING AT GUILD ART SHOWS (DOES NOT INCLUDE PERSPECTIVE GALLERY)

1. To Exhibit an artist must be a Guild member and in good standing. You must have attended two (2) meetings in the twelve months prior to the exhibition date.

2. The exhibit committee may reject any piece of art it deems inappropriate or in bad taste.

Artwork must have been completed within the past two years and not previously shown in any MPAG exhibitions. It must be original in concept and execution.

Work done in any class or workshop, and /or under the guidance of an instructor, even if the instructor did not work on the piece, is not eligible for entry.

Work painted from reference photos must be created from the artist's own photographs, not from any other photo source, copyrighted or not.

Artwork cannot be copied or photographed from newspapers, magazines or any other form of media pictures that have a LIC. No. Copying another artist's work will not be accepted.

The work is not a photographic computer generated or other form of electronically generated work.

Artificial intelligence, "AI" enhanced or created art is prohibited from entry into the Show.

Any artwork larger than 36" x 36", in a floater frame, must be approved by the committee chair, due to the possibility of strong winds.

All decisions by the committee concerning exhibits are final!

The decision of the judge (s) awarding ribbon is final!

3. Prints or giclée's will not be accepted to hang to sell on screens in shows.

However, two prints or giclée's are allowed to be sold at the sales table in the appropriate bin and must be signed with an authenticity paper stating it's a print copy of original artwork, sealed in a clear plastic sleeve. Printed Note cards of original artwork are also allowed to be sold.

4. No craft items (ornaments, magnets, jewelry, fabric, etc.) will be sold at shows.

5. Photography will be considered as a category, if there are enough entries.

6. Artwork must be framed or neatly finished in galley wrap style.

Artwork must be wired for hanging. No saw tooth hangers will be accepted.

7. All sales transactions (cash, checks, credit cards) will be conducted by the treasurer, acting treasurer, or the exhibit committee and or co-chairs. All checks will be made out payable to the Mount Pleasant Artists Guild or MPAG. All credit cards transactions will be processed only on the Guild's credit card machine.

15% of all sales will be donated to the Guild's Scholarship Fund.

The Guild will send participating artists, whose art, prints or note cards have been sold a check of the amount of the sale less 15% within 30 days after the exhibit.

8. Violations of the MPAG rules for exhibiting may result in suspension of exhibiting privileges for 12 months.
